Issac Thompson of couthfield (his home) in England married Frances' Harrison of Apleby, England. He is probably the Isaac Thompson Sr., aged about 70 who died 5 March 1841 and was buried 7th in St. Paul's Church register.

The family were 3 weeks coming by sailing vessel from Ingland, landing at Montreal they made their way up the great takes, settling at Port talhousie. It was not long before they bought a farm from Mr Street and went on to Bertie Township. In 1927 the home was still standing on Phipps St., Fort trie. It is now, I understand part of the lort trie hace Track, and it is for this family that Thompson would is named.
