

Records compiled from family records, and St. Paul's Church, Fort Erie

Isaac Thompson of Southfield (his home) in England married Frances Harrison of Apleby, England. He is probably the Isaac Thompson Sr., aged about 70 who died 5 March 1841 and was buried 7th in St. Paul's Church register.

The family were 3 weeks coming by sailing vessel from England, landing at Montreal they made their way up the Great Lakes, settling at Port Dalhousie. It was not long before they bought a farm from Mr Street and went on to Bertie Township. In 1927 the home was still standing on Phipps St., Fort Erie. It is now, I understand part of the Fort Erie Race Track, and it is for this family that Thompson Road is named.
