MARY (May) BENNER B. 1806 M. Benjamin Troup.

Janet Carnochan in History of Niagara records "On July 8, 1806, a Mary Benner, daughter of Jacob and Mary Benner, was baptised by Rev. Robert Addison of Niagara-on-the-Lake".

CATHARINE BENNER B. 1808 M. Aug. 14, 1839 to Abraham Beam, a widower from Willoughby. Their marriage is recorded at St. Paul's Anglican Church in Fort Erie. Witnesses were Jacob Benner and Jeremiah Trail. The 1851 census lists Catharine, now a widow, living with her parents, and a boy, Abraham Beam, B. 1840, presumed to be her son. They are both again listed in 1861 same place. * *

SUSANNA BENNER B. 1809 M. Jacob Michael B. 1801 in U.S.A.

See Michael geneology chart. There were many descendants through their son Jacob Michael II.

CHRISTENA BENNER B. 1814 Buried in Beach-Lutheran cemetery, Sherkston M. June 17, 1851 to Nicholas Michael II, Widower, B. 1801 D. 1852 Nicholas was a brother of Jacob Michael, married to Susanna Benner above. The 1861 Humberstone Twp. census lists Christena Michael, widow, living with her brother, Jacob I. Benner, and family.
