STEINMAN::: SUNSET DRIVE.

JACOB STEINMAN bought the farm and house of Wm. M. Graham on the west side of Sunset in 1833. He and his wife lived for a time when they first occupied the land, in the old Graham homestead which was a two story building of horizontal plank, construction. The ground floor contained two bedrooms on one side of the stairway and on the other side was one large room, that served as kitchen, dining room and living room combined. The upper floor was just one large room, and as there was no insulation of any kind, there was often snow on the beds. The home no doubt dated from the early 1880's and was not taken down till 1920.

Around 1879 the new brick home was built, to the front of the property closer to the road; and a covered passage way was built to connect the old Graham home to the new place. In later years, the new home was taken over by Albert Benner and his wife Flossie Steinman Benner, the place was Stuccoed over.
