In 1928 MR. Earle Cornell took over the business of P.A. Land on Jarvis St. He had worked under Mr. Land as an apprentence since 1920. Earle graduated from the school of Pharmacv in 1928, and when Mr. Land left the business after 32 years, to become manager of the liquor store on Gilmore Pd., Earle took over the store. from the Times Review 1928:::

"I will indever to give to von the same kind of service that Mr. Land  $^{\rm h}{\rm as}$  given you.

I do not wish to continue collecting the gas and water bills for the reason that I can devote my entire time to my nrofession; and to serving you.

I have acquired all the prescription files back to 190° and will be able to fill these as well as the new ones, at any time; with the utmost skill and accuracy, that is most descential in all cases.

I trust that you will place your confidence in me in the futer the future, as you have in MP. Land in the past."

Earle Cornell Pharmacist Fort Erie.

The store stayed much the same down through the years, however in Centennial year 1967 a large addition was made in the driveway on the East and Mr. Cornell was able to but in a large stock of China and gifts.

On Jan. 28th. 1974 Mr. Cornell closed the door to his Drug store; and made way for the new owners the Town Of Fort Frie.

They will begin to remodel, and when completed the building will house many of the Town offices.
