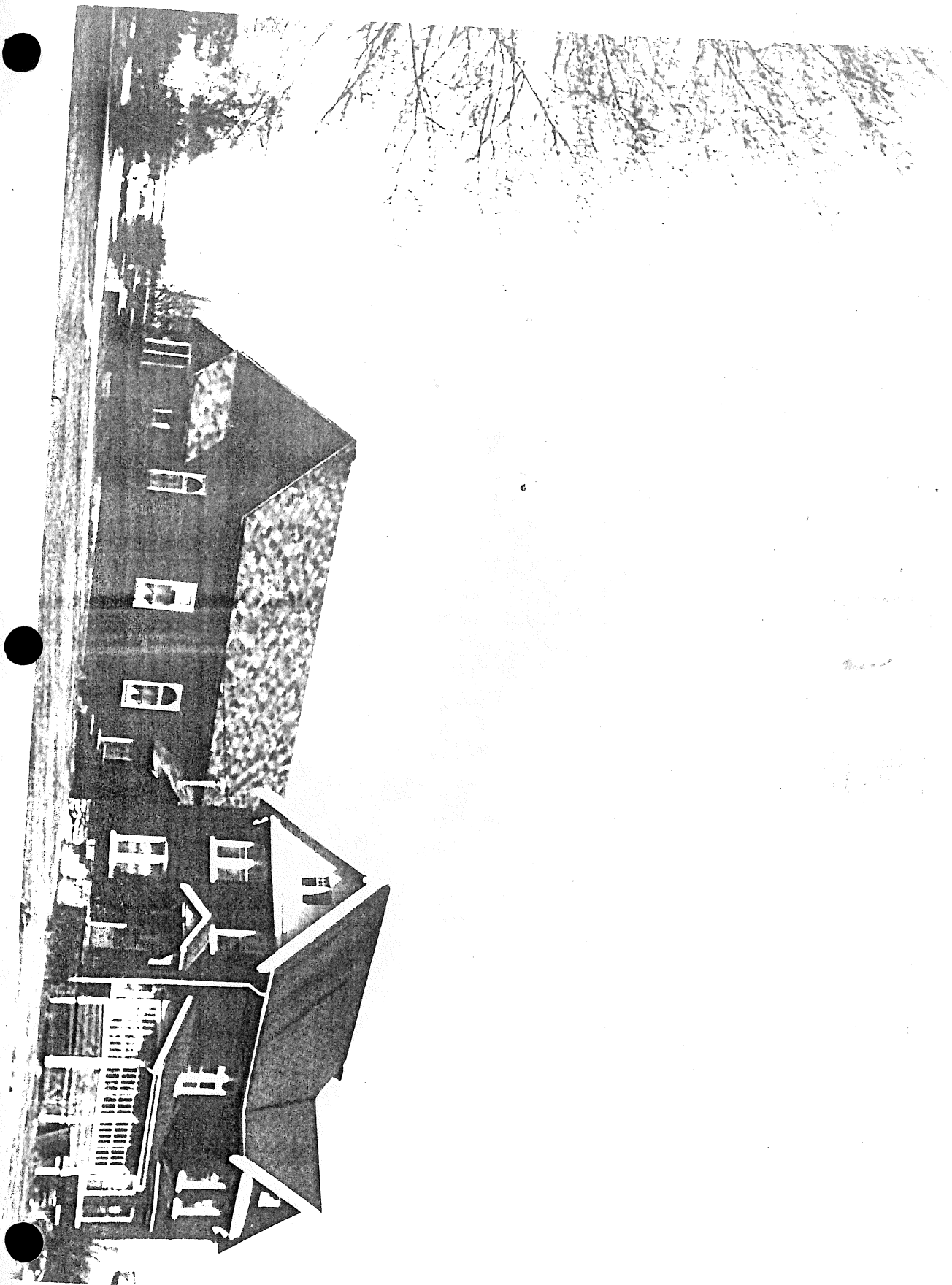

Feb. 3. 1927. Daniel W. Lang & wife to Fort Erie Estates.

Dec. 10. 1928. Fort Erie Estates Ltd. to the Municipal Corp. of the town of Bridgeburg.

Central Ave was not put through from Gilmore north till Jan 14. 1929 when land was given for the highway. The rd. running south from Gilmore was called Kincardin.

Aug. 9. 1927. A subdivision was planned for part of lot 3 on the north east Cr. of Gilmore and the newly proposed rd. Central Ave. Owners: J.B. Curtis & fort Erie Estates. This subd. never got underway.

1933. Treasurer of Ontario to the estate of Walter L. Curtis when mtg. repaid..
