JOHN FORSYTH ::: son of James & Eunice Forsyth of Niagara Falls born Jan. 3ist. 1781

John Fersyth removed to Batavia N.Y. and took up land from the Helland Land Company; accompanied by his brother William, later proprietor of the Pavillion Hetel in Niagara Falls Ont.

In 1810 John Fersyth married Miss Mary Gansen daughter of Capt. John Gansen of Lennington VF. They settled five miles from Batavia, near Dunham Greve, remaining there till 1805.

In 1805 Jehn Fersyth and his wife & child Edmund moved to land that was later to take the name of Warren's corner. in N.Y. state. He built a log cabin and later a tavern around 1808. After John's death Mary married Ezra Warren Iin 1813 and thus the name of the property became Warren's Corner.
