

JOHN FORSYTH ::: son of James & Eunice Forsyth of Niagara Falls
born Jan. 31st. 1781

John Forsyth removed to Batavia N.Y. and took up land from the
Holland Land Company; accompanied by his brother William, later
proprietor of the Pavillion Hotel in Niagara Falls Ont.

In 1810 John Forsyth married Miss Mary Gansen daughter of Capt.
John Gansen of Lennington VT. They settled five miles from Batavia,
near Dunham Grove, remaining there till 1805.

In 1805 John Forsyth and his wife & child Edmund moved to land that
was later to take the name of Warren's corner. in N.Y. state. He
built a log cabin and later a tavern around 1808. After John's
death Mary married Ezra Warren in 1813 and thus the name of the
property became Warren's Corner.
