DR. R. B. WAITE:: Laboratories 1925- 1947.

Dr. Waite was the owner of the Cooke -Waite Laboratories which manufactured local anaesthetics for teeth extraction. The laboratories were located on the south side of Queen St., just a few doors from the old town hall; and remained at that address till the plant moved to Windsor. Managing the Canadian plant were "r. & mrs. Fergusin, who continued to live at the Queen St. address after the plant closed.

Dr. Waite died at the age of 93, on Feb. 12, 1965 at his residence 367, Main St. Springville N.Y.

Older residents of the area will be sorry to learn of the death of Dr. Ralph B. Waite, on Friday, February 12, at his residence, 367 E. Main street, Springville, at the age of 93.

Dr. Waite was the owner of the Cooke-Waite Laboratories, which manufactured local anaesthetics for teeth extraction. The Laboratories were situated on Queen street from 1925 to 1947, when the plant was moved to Windsor. Managing the Canadian plant were Mr. and Mrs. John Ferguson who still reside in the same building.

Dr. Waite recently was presented with a 70 year pin from Spring the Lodge AM and AF and in June of 1956 the University of Buffalo conferred a citation on him for his research in the field of dentistry.

Funeral services were held at his residence, Tuesday, February 16.

Interment followed in Maplewood Cemetery, Springville.
