The CHICORA was built in Mersey 1864. Horse power 700. Length 230 ft. : breadth 48ft. it had a service span of 80yrs. It was used as a blockade runner during the American Civil War. Used on the Toronto to Niagara run, then moved to Lake Erie and ran from Buffalo to Grystal Beach. The Chicora did not carry autos.

The Cibola operated on the run from Toronto to Niagara. built 1888, and ran till it caught fire 1895.

THE CORONA: built 1896. operated from Toronto to Niagara, and remained in service till 1929. It held 1, 450 passengers.

THE CHIPPEWA : built 1893. operated from Toronto to Niagara. length 308 ft., and she carried 2000 passengers.

THE CAUGA: built 1935 for the Toronto to Niagara trade.
