ST. JOHN'S LUTHERAN CEMETERY ::: Sodom Rd. "ew Germany.

This very large cemetery stands on the east side of the Sodom Road just north of the center of the village, and opposite the United Church formerly St. John's Evangelical Church. There is a very large section containing a large number of the very old stones from the 1860's and 70's. A number of these are written in German. The cemetery continues to be used, and there are several hundred newer stones marking the graves of the descendants of these early settlers.
