In 1928 William Howard Rung married Maybel and they moved to Bridgeburg from the U.S.A. They took over the old building that stood on the river road between Dufferin and Phipps St. which in the 1820's was the Huffman House. For years it was used as a boarding house till the R ungs took over. They got a hotel licence and opened the place as the Howard Hotel, and remained in business for fourteen years. It had many owners and the name was later changed to the Ohio which remained for many years. The name was magain changed to the Lancashire Lass.
