BREWERS RETAIL STORE: 33 Gilmore Rd. Fort Erie. South side.

Fort Erie paper records date 1930 as opening: Bear & Ale. One of the oldest in the Province this outlet no. 33 on the lower end of Gilmore Rd. was opened by Charlie A. Muir. It was a large two story block building. On the upper floor Mr. Muir conducted the meetings and drills of the Lincoln and Welland Regt., of which he was in command.

In the spring of 1962 work was begun on the construction of a new store, behind the present building. This enabled the business to continue without disruption. On July 31 1962 the new retail store was opened, and the old building was demolished to provide parking space for customers.
