B.&S. Sept. 26, 1834 Timothy S. Hoyt to Jacob Benner 20 acres:  
Commencing at the south west of said lot #1, thence east on the  
Garrison line, 7 chns. 36 links: thence north 2 chns. 72 links  
Thence west 7 chns. 36 links to the allowance for a road in the  
rear of the said concession: thence south 2 chns. 72 links to the  
place of the beginning.

B.&S. Oct. 5, 1839 Cornelius Plato to Jacob Benner 3 rood; 15 prs.

JACOB I BENNER of Humbertstone:::

Jacob Benner and his wife Nancy <sup>MICHAEL</sup> (Huffman), lived on  
Willhelm Drive, north of the #3 highway, in Humbertstone. The farm  
was reached by a long laneway that headed west about a 1/4 mile  
from Willhelm Drive. Home and barn are still standing in 1974.

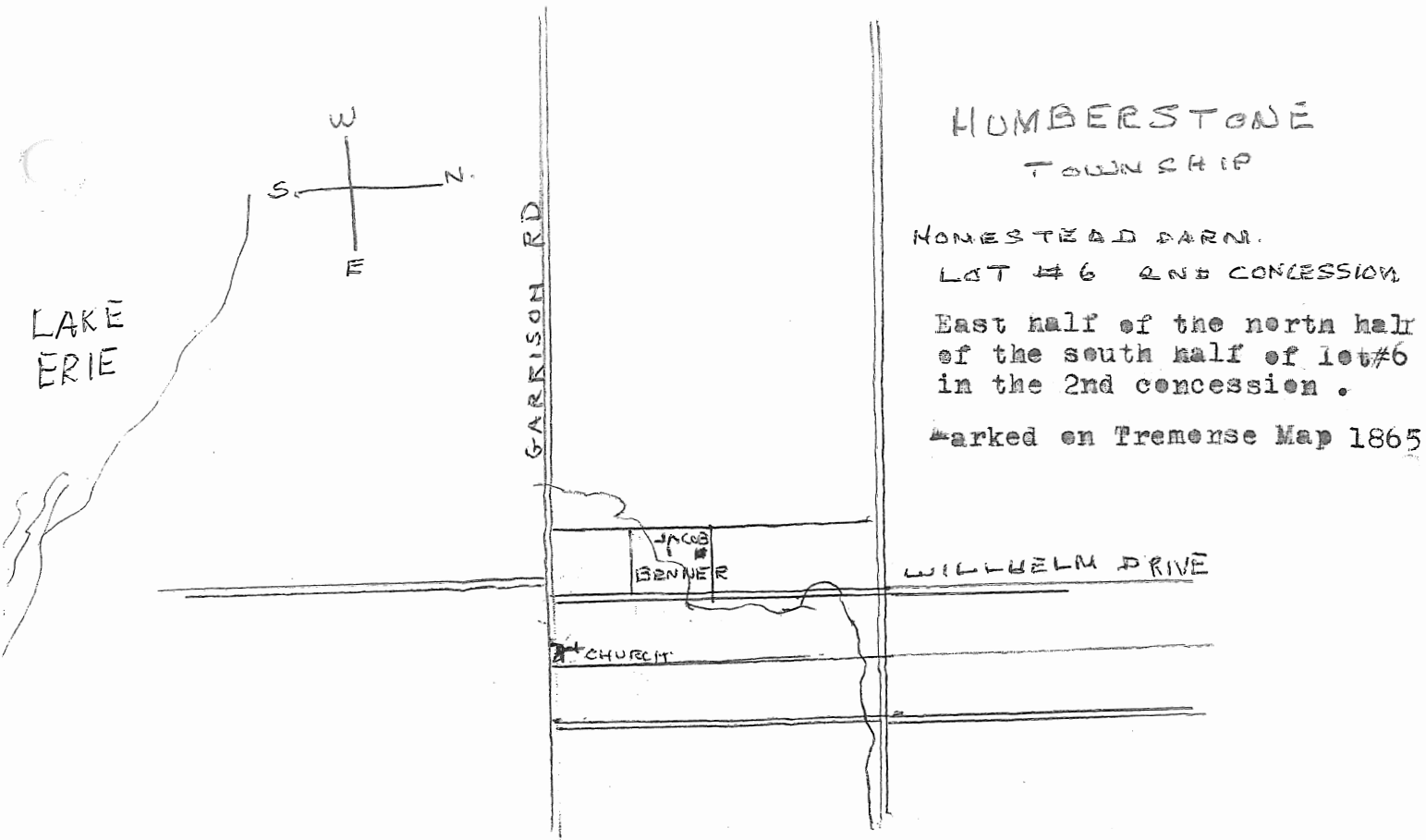
