1868 - 1945.

Born Jan. 6th., 1868 in Tonawanda N.Y. he moved to Grand Island with his parents when five years of age. After the death of his father he moved to Texas with his mother and brother for awhile, but returned again to the Island when his mother died.

He took employment with the J.C. Stearns Comp. as an electrician, and by the time he was 25yrs. of age he had become foreman. He resigned however shortly after and set up a partnership with his brother Charles to pursue his first love excursion boats.

The first boat planned and partly constructed by them was the SILVER KING. In the middle twenties, business boomed and they operated several boats on the Niagara and the lakes.

They aquired the BEDELL HOUSE on Grand Island, famous as a Hotel for the social set. Several times a day boats left from the foot of Ferry St for the Island. In 1934 Fatty agquired the Seabreaze, which for more than twenty years, carried passangers between Charlotte & Seabreeze on Lake Ont.
