The only child to survive the June, 1832 plague was the oldest one, John Riselay Miller who served (and survived) in the Battle of Ridgeway and was awarded land in Northern Ont. (Ochone District) which he never saw.

Children of Jacob Miller & Sophia (Riselay) Miller who are buried behind the Teachers Duplex in what used to be the old original orchard located to the east of the original Miller log house used by the family until the "new" home was built in 1826. This "new house" is the old part of the present building occupied now by the Redemptaristine Nuns just north of the NCC property. Part of the original house built in 1826, specifically the "summer kitchen" is the old house just south of Robt. Climenhaga's home.

These children all 6 years and under in age died in the diphtheria epidemic of June 1832.

The only child living at that time to survive was the eldest John Riselay Miller who lived to serve in the Battle of Ridgeway.

On July 1, 1867 he was a member of the Mounted Infantry Company, Volunteer Militia of the 44th Battalion at Stevensville, Ont. Source Public Archives of Canada.

The great grandmother of the 4 children listed above is also buried in the "Miller Burial Ground" behind the duplex. She died Dec. 4, 1802.

Notes

The home where Robert Climenbaga lives was known many years ago as the "Fure" home, I presume after a family that lived there and possibly built the house.

I believe Henry Cline (Kline) and latterly his son Ross lived there before Lloyd Wale of Stevensville acquired the property. This house stands approximately where the site (on the river bank) was of Decew's (De Cue) mill which was very successful except that every spring when the "runs" of lake ice came down the Niagara the water wheel, supports for beddings and the line shafting were torn out. Years later the iron anchors were still visible in the bed rock of the river. The mill site was abandoned and Mr. Decew moved to "somewhere's near Port Colborne" so its said. My great grandfather Jacob Miller and Robert Decew entered into this agreement of sale on Feb. 4, 1870. Robert Decew agreed to erect a mill in 1 year's time.

Just a scant 200 ft south of this site was "Uncle Charlie's" watering place (Charles A. Miller, an uncle of my dad's) where Uncle drove their livestock down to water; in recent times this exact spot (just above the reef (Decew's Reef)) has been used by BIC folks for Baptism's.

Also the 5 sisters of my great grandfather were defined as follows "The Miller girls were excellent horsewomen and expertly rode "side saddle" "
