 Samuel and John to be divided in equal

Shewes from Skirt to South. Philip Edmund shall have the west half and John shall have the East half to have and to hold the same to them severally and their and each of their heirs and assigns for ever; the lot of Ben was devised to me by my father the late Philip Bennet of Berte deceased composed of the South west part of Lot Niagara River in the Township of Berte Emmeil and devise unto my son James Emmanuel Bennet and his heirs and assigns for ever

Third of Will and bequeath unto my son Jacob Bennet the sum of five hundred Dollars and to my daughter Julia Ann wife of George Stearns Smith and bequeath the sum of two hundred Dollars payable to them or their representatives by my two sons Philip Edmund and John in equal shares within five years after my death and for which the devise to them of my Homestead Farm shall be held liable and also for the due support and comfortable maintenance of my wife Sophia should she survive me who shall have her home in the house upon the farm and to her use shall be provided by my said two sons a Store Buggy and harness and Teep for the said horse free Grant. I will and bequeath to my said two sons one team of horses and harness for the same and bequeath one place two harness and all the Tools Spades Shovel Ropes and Ropes upon the Farm to my three sons to sustain the families. I do

Wished all the residue of my personal estate to be by my Executors sold and the proceeds of the selling expenses to be divided among all my children having issue my son William of Denver his share portion I do not herein add anything further and

Wish I nominate and appoint my two sons William of Denver of the Township of Bertie Pleasant and Philip B. B. same also of Bertie Pleasant Executors to the my last Will and Testament hereby reserving all former Wills by me made
