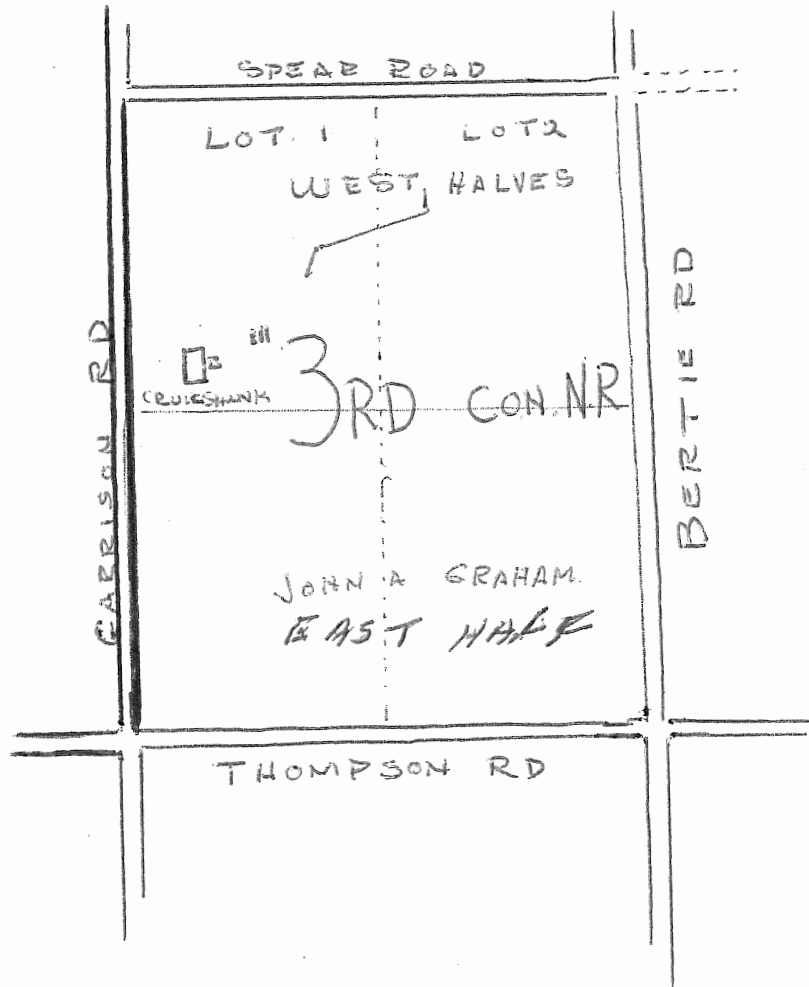

- 1835. July 18th. <sup>Dickson</sup> Mary T. Dixon executrix of Thomas Dixon grant to Adam Shipple 200 acrs. & 170.
- 1838. Adam Shipple eldest son, and heir of Conrad Shipple: grant to Daniel Paulis 100 acres W $\frac{1}{2}$  of lot 1 & 2 : & 500.
- 1847. Aug 30. Adam Shipple sold to James Windeat 100 acres : e.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of lot 1 & 2 & 450.
- 1847. May 29. Daniel Paulis grant to Benjamin Hershey 100 acres: w.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of lot 1. & 2. & 1250.
- 1856 APR. 20 REG Benjamin Hershey executor grant to ALEXANDER <sub>NO. 3579</sub> CRUIKSHANK 100 acres W  $\frac{1}{2}$  of lot L & 2 . 3 con. & 1250.
- 1861 Henry Withey sold to Richard Graham 100 acres: E.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of lots 1, & 2. & 1300.
- 1907. John Graham widower grant to Richard M. Graham 100 acres : E  $\frac{1}{2}$  pf lot 1 & 2 except right of way for power company. \$ 9000.
- 1910. Dec. 5. Lieut. Col. Ernest Cruikshank sold to Margaret C. Hofman : 100 acres W  $\frac{1}{2}$  of lot 1 & 2. Deed 3759. \$ 1. and other valued concessions.
- 1919. Apr. 17. John Graham willed to his son Richard M. Graham E  $\frac{1}{2}$  of lot 1. & 2.
- 1920. Aug. 30. John Mandill sold E.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of lot 1, & 2. to Garrison Heights Realty Company.
- 1921. July Agreement for sale: Margaret C. Hofman to Francis Alexander & Emma his wife : W.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of lot 1, & 2.
- 1964. Nov, 1st. Alec Alexander grant unto Richard J. Moore & Leone A. Moore as joint tenants: W  $\frac{1}{2}$  of lot 1 & 2. \$ 10,000.
