Hoyt~~ for and in consideration of the Sum of ~~Seventy five~~ Pounds ~~lawful Money of Upper Canada, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, transferred, conveyed and confirmed unto the said Jacob Bennett and to his~~ heirs and assigns, FOR EVER, ~~all and singular, that~~ certain parcel or Tract of Land and Premises, situate, lying, and being in ~~in the Township of Bertie~~ in the County of Lincoln in the District of Niagara and Province aforesaid, then containing by admeasurement, ~~two~~

~~acres to the land more or less being composed of Part of lot number one in the fourth concession of Bertie aforesaid. Which said two acres of Land are bounded and bounded or may be better known and described as follows; commencing at the South East angle of said lot number one, then East on the Garrison line about chains Thirty six links from North two chains & seventy two links. Then West about chains Thirty six links to the allowance for road in rear of said concession. Then South two chains Seventy two links to the place of Beginning.~~
