THE GEAR HOME::: Niagara River Road, Fort Erie.

Nov. 2nd. 1918. The Gear home now remains empty.

It was built over 100 yrs. ago.

In 1812, it was the Conference headquarters for the American & British parties. It is of the old Colonial Style, and under it's exspansive roof, terrorized wifes and children of the Niagara pioneers found shelter and protection from hostel Indians. It is surrounded by the most pictureque, estate along the Niagara frontier.
