

STEVENS:::

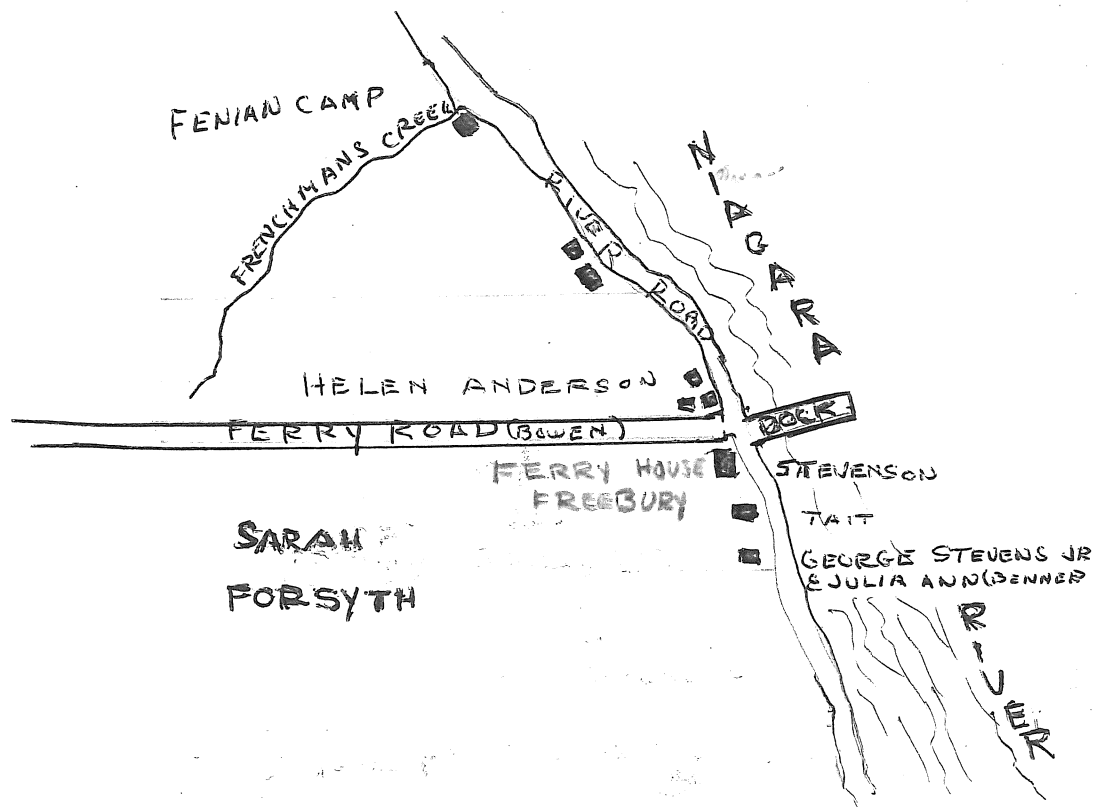
JOSEPH STEVENS b. 1833. d. July 27. 1887. 46yrs.  
buried in Ridgeway Cemetery Garrison Rd.

Although not marked his wife is buried next grave.  
also Frank Stevens is buried here.

George Stephens son of Joseph & Margaret Stephens  
b. 1861 d. July 27th . 1887 : 26yrs.

they had four childre; Howard: George Frank Dolly: murre

Joseph Stevens operated a Hotel on the river road in the 1860's  
by the foot of Ferry St. (Boweb Rd.) It is said by his grand-  
daughter that at one time he also owned the dock and the shingle  
mill. During the Fenian Raids O' Neil spared the hotel and the  
shingle mill. Mr. Stevens became ill however and moved to a farm  
on Gilmore Rd. He did not remain there long for the Stevens had  
a story and a half frame home built on the south side of Gilmore,  
and what later became Kingsmill , in 1869. It was the only home  
on that side of the street from concession to the river.
