No. 80(01d) Niagara Blvd. new 463 Niagara Blvd.::: 1880's Harry Stone. Harry Stone was the first druggist in old Fort Erie. His place of business was in the north section of the old Pool room building on the riverside of Niagara Blvd., owned by Ed. Hawkins. The south end of the building housed a grocery store, and the rear of the building housed the pool hall. This actually was a betting parlor, however in later years it became a regular pool, a billiard hall.

In 1927 John & elsie( Montillon) Fitzgibbon moved into the home, with their children after a move from Port colborne. After the death of Mr. Fitzgibbon , . ,Elsie moved with her daughter Mary back to the old Montillon home at No. 96 Niagara blvd. She sold the home to Albert T. Elliott: Apr. 26th. 1934.
