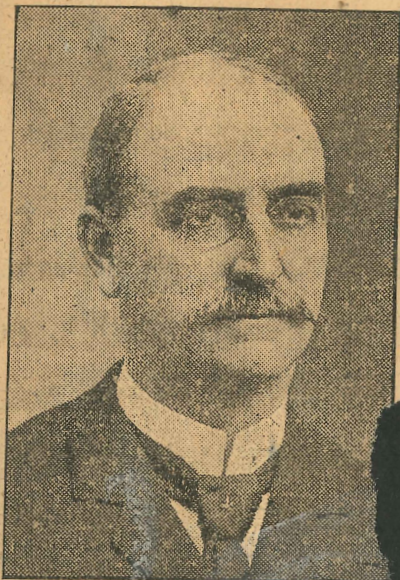


**BRIDGEBURG BUSINESS

BRIDGEBURG, Ont., Oct. 12—(Special).—The funeral of Alfred B. Hurrell was held this afternoon, with interment at St. Paul's Anglican cemetery. The Rev. A. Cameron Mackintosh officiated.

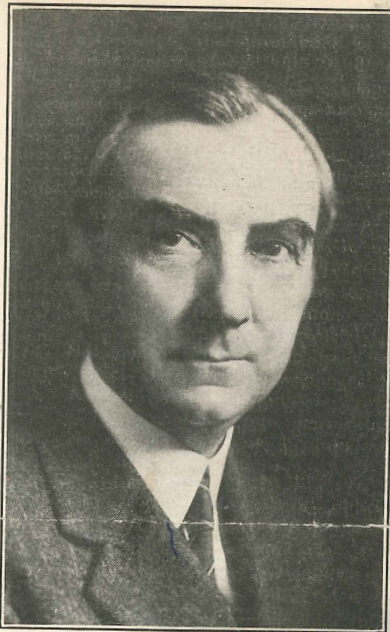
Mr. Hurrell died Monday. His wife and two children survive—Alfred Hurrell of Glen Ridge, N. J., a prominent lawyer, who has held several important positions at Albany, New York, and other places, and a daughter, Dr. Louise Hurrell of Rochester, N. Y.

The funeral services were conducted under the auspices of International I. O. O. F. lodge. Mr. Hurrell was also a member of Palmer Masonic lodge, having held high honors in that order.

He was one of the first to support the project of locating here a Y. M. C. A. branch, and was a charter director of that institution.

As reeve of Bridgeburg, Mr. Hurrell's sound business administration will be long remembered. He was a member of the council when a business man in the south ward, and brought, in addition to the town in general, many desired improvements to that locality.

Mr. Hurrell was one of the pillars of the local Anglican church, having been warden for a number of terms. He was in business in the Amigari
