HERSHEY
BORN
AUG. 9, 1889
DIED
MAY 18, 1919
HERSHEY
-tall, greyish, rectangular-shaped monument
(four-sided), about five feet high
-lettering faces west
-stone is upright and in good condition
-carving of leaves and flowers at top on all
four sides
2. SALOME
wife of
JOHN B.
HERSHEY
DIED
OCT. 22, 1881
AGED 61 Y'RS
-a long, rectangular-shaped stone lying flat
in the ground
-has a large crack with grass growing
through it in the middle
-faces west
-face of the stone has been eroded
3. IN MEMORY OF
JOHN B. HERSHEY
DIED
May 29, 1904
Aged 88 years
3 mos & 15 d's
-tall, thin, white stone with a rounded top
stone is upright and faces west
lettering is fairly easy to read, but has
eroded quite a bit
- I am the ressurection, the truth
and the life to those
that follow me. Yet shall
he live.
4. IN
MEMORY OF
LAWRENCE E.
WEGFOR
-small, white stone with a rounded top edge
-rest of the stone has been broken off
-stone is upright, but is leaning to the left
-faces west
-lettering is easy to read
5. -unmarked grave
-sunken plot of ground indicates a burial
6. HENRY HERSHEY
Died Oct. 7, 1860
Aged 74 y's 2 mo.
& 28 days
-tall, thin, white stone
-has picture of a weeping willow at the top

Farewell seeking mourners with sad broken hearts,
O hasten to Jesus and take the good part,
He is full of compassion & mighty to save,
His arms are extended your souls to receive.

-stands upright facing east
7. MARY
Wife of
HENRY HERSHEY
Died Mar. 20, 1857
Aged 60 y'rs 7 m
& 16 d's
-tall, thin, white stone, standing upright
-faces west
-picture of a willow at the top of the stone
8. BENJAMIN HERSHEY
BORN
in Lancaster Co.Pa. 1776
came to Canada 1795
DIED
NOV. 26, 1831
Aged 55 years
-stone faces west, and stands upright
-tall, thin, white, rectangular-shaped stone
-very plain
- A)
-small, white footstone without any letters
or engraving
-stands upright
9. In memory of
ANNA
Wife of
HENRY HERSHEY
DIED
Feb. 15, 1872
Aged 86 Years
3 ms. & 10 D's
-small, white, thin, rectangular-shaped stone
-stands upright facing west
very plain
10. MARGARET
Wife of
ABRAHAM HERSHEY
BORN
-----, 1771
-stone is lying flat on the ground "facing"
west
-a large piece of the stone is missing so
that it is impossible to find the date of
death
-finger pointing skyward at the top of the
stone
11.
-a square area surrounded by square cement
blocks (probably a family plot)
-it is about six or seven feet square
- A)
-small footstone on the east side of square
-top is broken off
-no writing on the stone
12. THS
REMEMBER PAUL
1906
1947
-a cross-shaped marker
-lettering is fairly easy to read
-stone faces west

MEMORY OF

DIED
June 28, 1900
AGED
70 YEARS
11 MO. & 14 D'S

HE DIED AS HE LIVED,

-small footstones with the writing on the top

19. FLORENCE A. OGDEN
WIFE OF
JOHN G. EMBLETON
1895 -- 1967

-small, polished stone, lying flat in the
ground
-in good shape

20. (on the east side)
OUR BABY

(on the west side)
SON OF
HENRY & MARY E.
JOHNSTON
BORN & DIED
DEC. 2, 1891

-carving of a rose at the top of the east side
-small, white stone, still in the base and
sturdy
-rounded at the top
-in good condition

21 -- 25.

-unmarked graves
-sunken plots of ground indicating burial

26. IN MEMORY OF
WALTER ACKER
1881 -- 1961

-thick, small stone facing west
-in good condition: sturdy

27. OAKLEY
HAROLD OAKLEY
1895- 1959
IN LOVING MEMORY

-black, polished stone facing west
-very good condition: stable
-four roses carved into the top

28.

-unmarked grave
sunken plot of ground indicates burial

29.

-thin, white stone with no lettering: has been
broken off and the top is missing
-faced west
