OBITUARY.

MARIA EVERETT.

An old and highly respected resident of River Side, Willoughby, died at her late residence on March 28, 1897, in the person of Maria Everett, relict of the late Jacob B. Everett, in the 80th year of her age. Deceased was born May 20th, 1817, in Aurora, state of New York, and had resided at the homestead, where she died, for the period of sixty years. Although in failing health for some time she was only confined to her bed two weeks previous to her death. She was a person of superior mental attainments, and was in possession of all her faculties and her mind was clear to the last. Deceased was a member of the Methodist church and was always cheerful and hopeful and died trusting in her Saviour.
