

THE JAMBOREE REST. DOMINION RD. OPENED May 29th. 1955.

the owners were two gentlemen from Buffalo: STAN ZAPPIA & DOMINIC GAMBINO.

The Manager was Lyn Powell. The Jamboree was only open in the summer months, weekdays till 2.A M. and sunday till 11.pm.

Working along with Mrs. Powell were Sue Paterack and Heintz Hummel. When Lyn retired Sue took over as manager.

Eventually the original owners sold to Karl & Connie( Powell) Haliskii. Picnic tables were added around the grounds, and there was also a large indoor eating room with a Juke box for dancing.

Karl built the large home to the west shortly after taking over the business. There was a small stream along side the parking lot so he had a small bridge installed , for passing from the home to the Rest. Karl worked in the front yard at Horton Steel. Sue was then employed as manager.

The Jamboree had been up for sale for about two years when it was destroyed by fire Aug. 72 or 73. The fire was such that two fire depts. answered the call. Bruntons Grocery Store across the street had a great deal of damage done to the front of the business.

the Haliski's never did rebuild. Their home next door was saved but they left for northern Ont. The property now houses, Paterak's Landscaping and supply.
