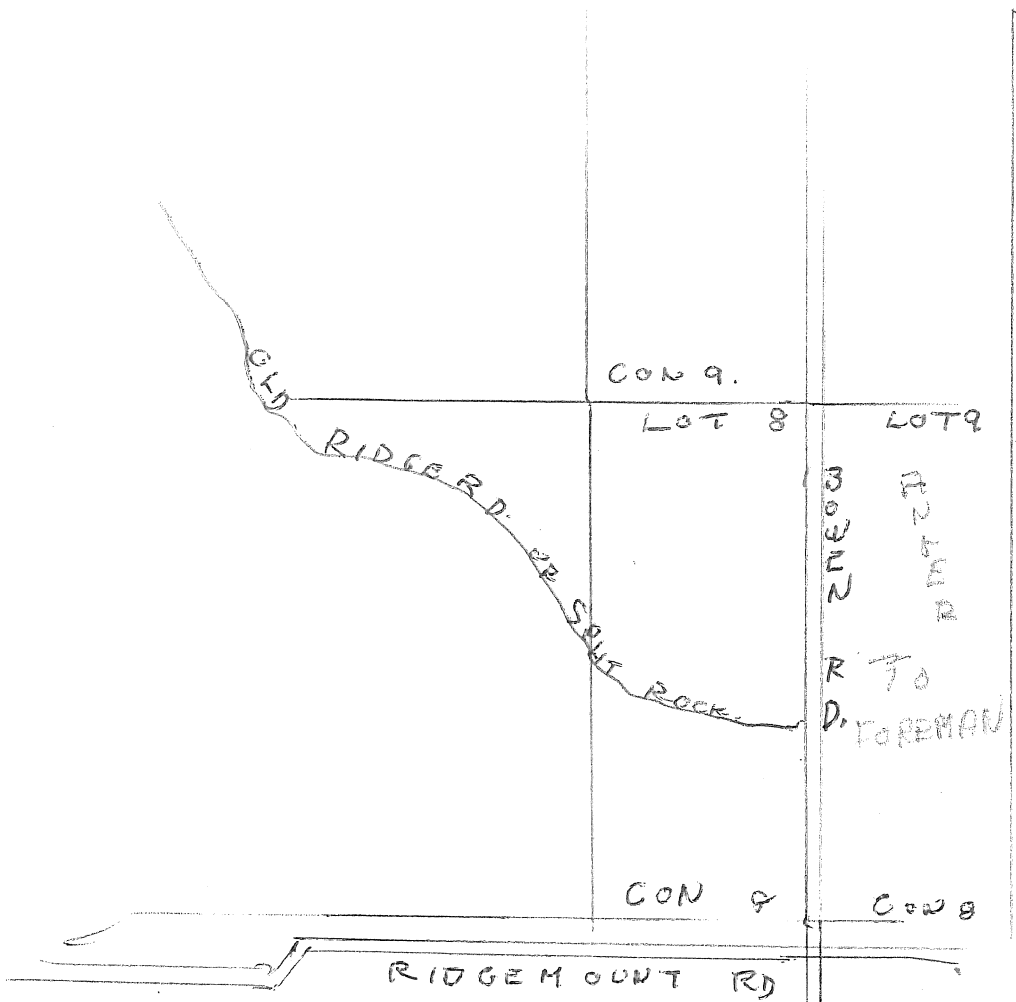

John Miller lived on the farm at the south west corner of Bowen road and the Old Ridge(or Split Rock)(1983 Keith Miller) It was then lived in by his son Henry Miller. He had a son John who was the grandfather of Ernest Miller.

John Miller built his home on the North side of Bowen, just facing Ridge Rd. (Split Rock) Originally Split Rock ran along the west side of this house and down along the north side of St. John;s Church comming out by the old Dennahouer Cemetery.

Another son John also lived in this old homestead.
