1873. Inn: Joseph Bauer.

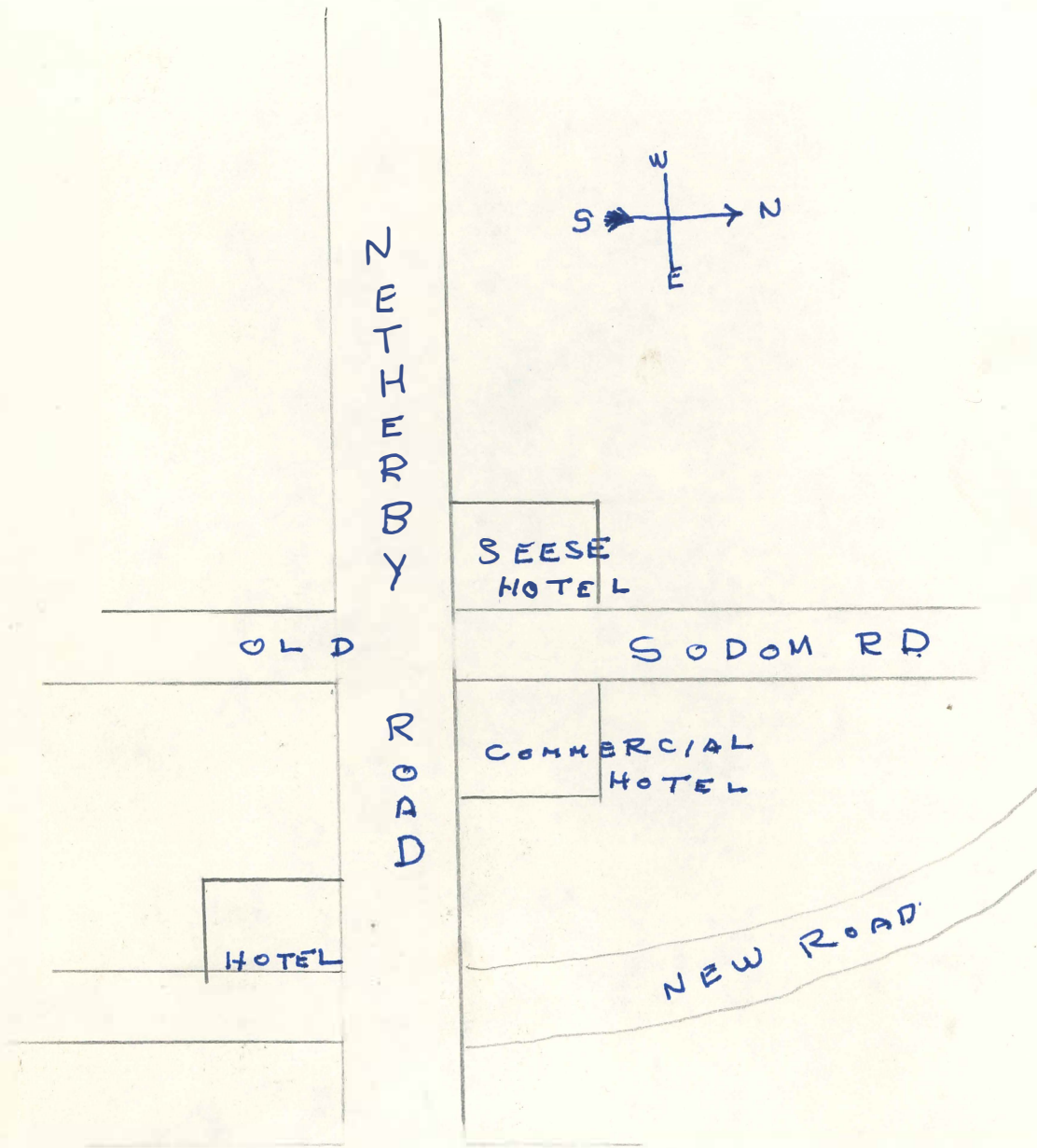
1910. Inn Andrew Willick. During the 1st world war , they lost licquor licence, but operated a store from this building, as well as renting rooms ans serving meals. In 1934 the licence was again granted, and the Willick family continued in business till 1948.

1948. In Sept the Hotel was purchased by Andrew Zuba.

1974 Hotel sold to John Mikitchuk & Roger Featherstone

1977 New owners Bill and Andie Warbuck.

1978. Andie bought out his partner Bill and the Hotel was then operated by Andie and his wife Dorothy and their son Andrew.
