John H. Atwood came to Fort Erie from the family home in Willoughby on the river road lot 10. S.E. angle : B.F. He arrived in the village Oct.1. 1890. He opened a grocery store on the north side of Jarvis St.in the middle of the block, in later years the site of the A.P. store. In 1891 he bought the undertaking business.By 1892 he had built himself a home, store, and carried on his undertaking business in a large barn at the rear. It stood or the north west carner of Dufferin and Klauck Streets. He carried on both businesses here till 1932. Early in 1939 a fire destroyed the barn and the class hearse that he had stored there.

In 1895 John had gone into the furniture business. In 1928 he built a new store on the north side of Jarvis, to the east of the old post office. In 1931 he built several homes on the south side of Wintemute St., one for himself and others for family members. On this same location he opened his undertaking parlor and funeral business in Oct. 1940.
