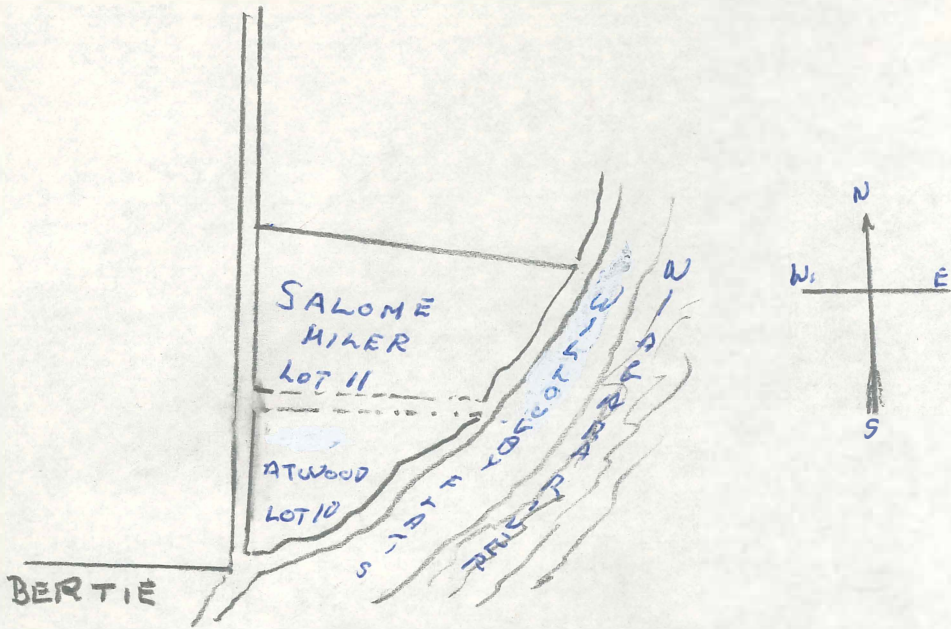


Property deeded to Salome Miller 1836 by her father John Miller:::

lots situated as follows::: 1. being composed of the north part
of lot # 13, in the 5 con. containing 20 acres.

2. lot:: south part of lot 14, in the 5th. con. containing $66\frac{1}{2}$ acres

3. north half of lot # 13 in the 6th. con. containing 50 acres,
also reservation for a roadway , on lot 13, in the 5th con::
all in Bertie Township and left at his death to brother Edward
Kerr Miller.

4. lot situated and being in the Township of Bertie, containing
 $1\frac{1}{2}$ acres: commencing at the north east angle of lot fifteen, in
the fifth con. of the said Township: one chain from the Niagara
River, thence west six chains more or less to a stone planted:
thence south two and a half chains : thence east six chains, to
within one chain of the Niagara River: thence north two and one
half chains to the place of the beginning.

This land left to sister Adela Salome, Miller at the time
of his death.

John A Miller was living in the red brick home with his parents
and after their death. In his will he granted a sum of \$1,200.00
to Rebecca Anquish the adopted daughter of Edward Miller and
Salome, and he granted her the right to live in the old home-
stead with free board.
