

FEDDER'S MNFG: Jennet St. Bridgeburg Ont.

June 24. 1920. James M. Carter & wife sold to Louis F. Fedders.

Mar. 3. 1922. Fedder's Mftg. Company of Buffalo to purchase the Lautz Marble Wks. plant on Jennet St. They will manufacture automobile parts, and are to employ between 200 & 500 men.

Dec. 1922. Fedder's never opened because of customs regulations. They had put in thousands of dollars in this operation and 1923 sold out to Horton Steel Works.

May 12. 1923. Louis F. Fedders ~~grantor~~ of the city of Buffalo, Erie County N.Y. , manufacturer herein after called the grantor of the first part and Horton Steel Works Ltd. a corporation of the Dominion of Canada, having as it's principal office, a place of business in Bridgeburg Ont., herein after called the grantor of the second part: & Florence Kroll Fedders wife of the grantor, herein called the party of the third part. Value buildi ngs and land: \$35,000.
