THE WILL OF ADAM LICHTENBERGER::: July 17th. 1907.  
born Jan 3rd, 1838 died June 29th. 1907

Administrators::: John Licht. & Frederick Licht. executors.  
(Margaret Licht. duly renounced. )

Sons John & David lands already given; to pay the estate \$500.00 each: and bequeathed to said sons, between them 1 plough, one harrow, one scarifier, and two lumber wagons; and the cattle that are now on the farm TO daughter Carrie Fretz, \$500.00: to my daughter Mrs. Lizzie Langerdorfer the sum of \$1000.00: to son Adam the farm known as Lee Farm, being part of lot # 14 in the 7th. concession N.R. and \$ 500.00.

To son Phillip the sum of \$ 2000.00; To son Frederick I bequeath the farm lot being # 11 in the 6th. Concession N.R. in the Town. Bertie. Wife Margaret to have life lease of the home and then to the son Frederick. All money in the bank to be equally divided between wife Margaret & son Frederick. The sheep and the young cattle are to be sold by my executors and the proceeds to go between my sons JOHN, David, Frederick, & Adam. All the residue of my estate not here before disposed of I give, devise & bequeath unto my dear wife Margaret, and my son Frederick.
