

New Ferry Boat Run

A new ferry boat, the Niagara Frontier, goes into commission on Saturday with a capacity of 35 automobiles and 700 passengers, running between Ferry street and Fort Erie. Grounds have been laid out at Erie Beach and fitted up for athletic contests and for picnics or any other purpose desirable for great crowds, as well as lesser ones.

No intoxicating liquors will be sold on the grounds. Many dates have been secured by fraternal and other organizations including Sunday-schools for outings and picnics at the Beach during the summer, including bankers of Western New York. The boat goes into commission running from the foot of Main street to the new docks at Fort Erie Beach about the first of July.

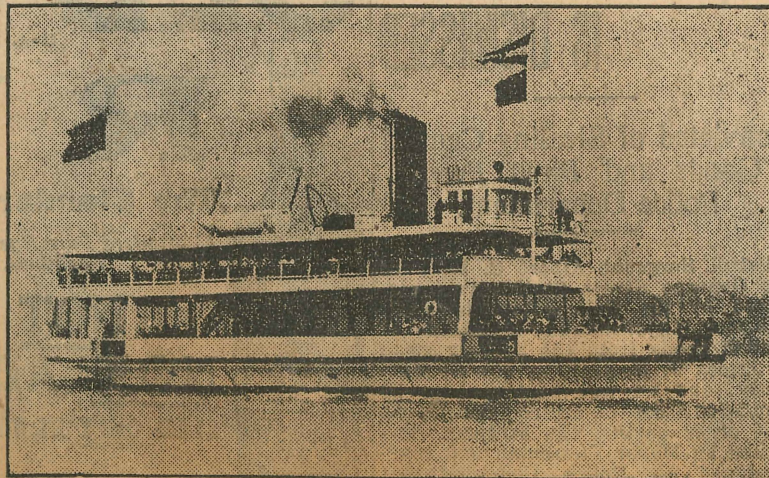
