

Daniel PAULUS FARM::: WEST PART OF LOT 1 CON. 3. L.E. South side Garrison Rd. 767

1801. Crown to Joseph Palmer lot 1. & 2. con 3. L.E.

Daniel Paulus had his homestead farm 1846 - 1882.

Apr. 13. 1846. James Brewer ; N.Y. State sold to Daniel Paulus lot 1 con 3. LE.  
92 acres.

July 20. 1882. Death of Daniel Paulus Sr.

Aug. 24. 1882. Will of Daniel Paulus Sr.: to grandsons James White: John White:  
grand daughters, Margaret: Elizabeth & Dollie White.

1882. To Margaret Paulus wife: west part of lot 1. con.3. farm he then  
occupied 93 acres west part. & lots 1.2.3. on the east side  
of Helen St. 28 .1/4 acres.

1882. West part to Margaret Paulus life lease and to Daughters  
Elizabeth Turner & Esther Dambach: 55 acres.

This included the 1.1/2 story house: 2 large barns , one new and  
one in good repair.

1882. David Paulus all of East lot 1, except 6 acres. S.E. cr. sold  
to Edwin Finch. 28 and 1/4 acres in all.

1882. John Paulus lots 1.2.3. on east side of Helena St. 28 1/4 acres.  
mgt, Ernest Cruikshank & David Plato.

1904. Esther Dambach to Anton Geiger : 12.1/2 acres including homestead.  
There were two Geiger brothers living in home. They were from  
Buffalo N.Y. and were piano builders ( info. from Alec Alexander.  
etc. etc.

1942. Erie Beach Company to Ray Plato.

Franklin Plato. died Aug. 19. \_\_\_\_\_

Mable Evelyn Plato wife of Franklin died July 16, 1988.

Home sold to Joe Marino (rented out).

The Daniel Paulus Farm of 55 ACRES had 2 good barns at the time of his death in  
1882, one new and one in good repair: a good story and a half house,  
painted and furnished throughout: on a stone foundation: a food  
cellar in excellent condition a good young orchard ; five acres of  
grafted fruit, apples, pears & plums and a moving stream that waters  
the farm and 15 acres of fair brush.
