

PARKVIEW REST. NIAGARA BLVD. FORT ERIE lot

- After Mr. Shaw vacated his store here on March 26, 1955, the place went to Lee B. Kee & Lee Sea who operated a chinese restaurant here. *shaw opened Crescent Park 1957*
- Nov. 7, 1955: lee B. Kee & lee Sea sold to Pat Cheu.
- Feb. 9, 1967: store lease from Pat Cheu to Louis Louie & Joseph Chung. Rest. Called the Parkview.
- Mar. 25.1970 Grant Jen Cheu & Eddie Cheu executors of Pat Cheu to Jen Cheu and Eddie Cheu as joint tenants.
- Louis Louie was forced to leave the old Parkview. and opened his own rest. across the street May 1975. He took the Parkview name with him .
- June 8 1978. Eddie Cheu started the construction of his new restaurant. He demolished the old Muscoff home just north of the rest, and built his new place on it. When completed he then had the old Parkview Rest. demolished and along with it the small addition that had been Pongs laundry.
1978. Jen Cheu to Eddie Cheu & Carrol Cheu as Joint tenants.
- Mar. 22. 1979. Eddie Cheu opened his new restaurant with the name May Wah
