What does the Niagara District Health Council's future vision of our health care mean to you?

What the Health Council says:

(1)"The most specialized level of health care will be provided by a State-of the-Art Hospital and Emergency service, which are supported by satellite Ambulatory Clinics."

(2)"It is expected that there will be fewer Hospitals in Niagara's Health System."

(3)"Niagara's Health System will be <u>Led</u> and <u>Managed</u> by a single Local Organisation."

What this Could mean for You and Your Family:

- Instead of a 24 hour Emergency service there will be a Walk-in Clinic open 12 hours per day but no service at night.
- No hospital beds for Intensive Care, Maternity, Paediatrics and Surgical Patients.
- A 30 minute car or ambulance ride (if available) to the nearest Hospital.
- Small hospitals will likely be targetted for closure.
 ie: Douglas Memorial Hospital
- This means a Regional Health Board similar to Regional Government with Fort Erie having very little voice.
