To Your Excellency in Council that your Petitioner suffer'd very much by Fines, Imprisonment and other Oppression from the Americans during the late War and that he came and put himself under the British Government soon after the war was over and has lived ever since in this District-

Begs to inform Your Excellency that there is a small Creek a little below Point Ebeno" above Fort Erie running thro a piece of waist land from a Swamp capable of Erecting a small Mill for the Benefit of the

Neighborhood which is much wanted there.

Your Petitioner therefore most humbly Requests that your Excellency will please to permit him to build a Mill thereon and grant him one Hundred Acres of Land adjoining thereto on the same Terms as is granted to the rest of the Province-

And Your Petitioner will be ever bound to Pray

We the undernamed subscribers living in the Nabourhood about Point Ebeno humbly Crave that this Petition may meet with your Excellency's Approbation as we are in great want of a Grist Mill in this part of the Settlement.

On December 31, 1798, DANIEL FORSYTH received a Crown Patent in Humberstone Township, as follows:

"Daniel Forsyth received 393 acres of Crown land. The front of lots 4 and 186 5 of concession one, on Lake Erie that is to say, beginning at the southwest angle of lot 5 being the southeast angle of lot number 6 on the bank of Lake Erie, then north to lands surveyed for James House, 97 chains, 50 links more or less, then east 4I chains, then south to the bank of the lake, then westerly along the bank to the place of the beginning."
