He stated that he was one of those unfortunate Loyalists who was obliged to abandon the country of his nativity, and fly for protection to the British standard at New York: from where at the conclusion of the war he emigrated to the Province of Quebec; and soon afterwards became a settler in Upper Canada. He is now resided in the neighbourhood of Fort Erie , where he has located a farm of 200acres. He produced a cerifiacate frfm Major Van Alstine, the leader of his party from New York.

" I do certify that the above John Johnson(Jansen) was an officer of the Royal Standard in Newyork in the year 1777 , and there remained to the year 1783; from whence he took shipping and came to the Province of Quebec: has lost property." On the 14th., of July 1796 the Council recommended a grant of 200 acres in addition."

He served for five years as a private in Butler's Rangers, and had a wife and four children. In May 1796 he stated that he received only 200 acres and applied for additional land. He was recommended for 100 acres in addition, on producing his discharge.(13, July, 1796) In a second petition he stated that he had brought his wife and two children into the province in 1787; and applied for 100 acres to complete his military lands, and family lands for his wife and children. On June 30, 1798, he was recommended for 250 acres, under the old regulation.

The petition of Elizabeth Johnston(Jansen) now of Newark undated but received by the Clerk of the Council on May 10th., 1797; stated that she was the widow of the Loyalist who served during the war with the commission of Capt. in the Indian Dept. John Johnston (Jansen) and is the mother of Capt. John Powell and Lieut. William Johnston of the same dept.

" That during the war she was at a very great expence in furnishing the Parties of the Government with provisions; and being now blind and infirm, throws herself upon the bounty of the government , to witch she has ever been a faithful servent, and prays for and allowance of land" An order was made to her for a grant of 400 acres.

A gravestone built into the wall of the Servos family burial ground at Palstine Hill in the Township of Niagara bears the following inscription:

" Sacred to the memory of Eizabeth Johnsin, who died 8th., nov. 1811. aged 104 years.
