Bentie Aug 8th 1887

I know all格iven by this document that Henry
Grimmer of Township of Bentie in County of Wel-
land and Province of Ontario feeling the life
to all humanity is uncertain and that any
person owning property and dying without
such property is liable to waste and loss to the
heirs interested.

I do this eighth day of August in the year one
hundred and thousand eight hundred and eighty-one
make my will giving instructions as in case of
my death to how I wish my property divided
I do hereby declare that said divide any farm
of 80 acres more or less between my two sons
and Grimmer as follows. Herald to have the south
portion and Grimmer the North section then sep-
arate properties to be divided by the road allow-
ance running East and West each road allow-
ance as runs between lots two and three in fifth
parties concession Niagara River and their respective lots
shall contain as near as possible as 10 acres
otherwise the honestad to Herald and the lotce
of about 50 Acres as herein described to Grimmer
and since the said my daughters named as
follows Miss, Martha and Claude do just share

in the land the two sons already mentioned shall become equally responsible for the payment to lack of said daughters when they become competent. Within eighteen years of age the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars shall consist in part of a legacy left by Bridget Blackmarch deceased which is now held against my Estate and bearing interest at eight per cent.

With respect to any chattel property such as farms stock farm implements household property or any other property of a moveable nature the Executors do appoint shall have power to convert same into money in any way they may see fit and shall and reserve such funds for the maintenance of any member of the family that may be minors and incapable until so provided for themselves and any funds arising from the property such as rent or shares of grain shall be reserved for a like use and be used as the Executors shall deem proper at some time exercising due caution to act for the interest of the several members of my family in case of any debts becoming due against myself take my two sons herald and hamer shall be cease responsible for same when hamer becomes twenty one years of age and also in case of my purples of funds available due the Estate when hamer becomes twenty one years of age such sum shall be divided equally between all living members of my family Agreed to above I do hereby declare that my mind is strong and healthy and in every way fit to make my Will which is herein declared and in order to carry this will into effect I do hereby appoint Philip & Thomas and William & Bennett as executors to this will and say my
