The last Will and Testament of Henry
Warner late of the Township of Bertie in the
County of Prichard Henrico deceased referred
to in the foregoing letters Testamentary

Bertie Aug 27th 1889

Know all men by this document that Henry
Warner of Township of Bertie in County of Prich-
ard and Henrico of Quarters feeling that life
to all humanity is uncertain and that any
person owning property and dying intestate
such property is liable to waste and loss to the
heirs interested

I do this eighth day of August in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one
make my Will giving, instructing as (in case of
my death) to how I wish my property divided
I do hereby declare that I will divide my farm
of 80 acres more or less between my two sons Gerald
and Warner as follows Gerald is to have the south
portion and Warner the North portion their por-
tions properties to be divided by the Road allow-
ance running East and West such good allow-
ance as runs between lots two and three in fifth
concession Reagan River and their respective lots

shall contain as near as possible as 30 acres
otherwise the same to be to Gerald and the same
of about 50 acres as herein described to Warner
And since the said my daughters named as
follows Mica, Martha and Maude do not share

in the land. The two pias already mentioned shall become equally responsible for the payment to each of said daughters when they become respect-ably eighteen years of age the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars each paid one hundred and fifty dollars shall remain in part of a legacy left by Prichard MacArthur deceased which is now held against my estate and bearing interest at Eight per cent.

With respect to my chattle property such as farms stock farm implements household property or any other property of a movable nature the Executors I do appoint shall have power to convert same into money in any way they may see fit and hold and receive such funds for the maintenance of any member of the family that may be minor and in a phisicall manner for themselves and any funds arising from the property such as rent or shares of grain shall be received for a life use and be used as the Executors shall deem proper at some time exercising due caution to act for the interest of the several members of my family.

In case of any debts becoming due against myself or my two sons Gerald and Warner shall be some responsible for same when Warner becomes twenty one years of age and also in case of any surplus of funds available due the Estate when Warner becomes twenty one years of age such surplus shall be divided equally between all living members of my family.

Agreed to & above I do hereby declare that my mind is strong and healthy and in every way fit to make my Will which is herein declared and in order to carry this Will into effect I do hereby appoint Philip & Warner and William A Warner as Executors to this Will and at some time
