Since the advent of the Telephone into the Village the Telegraph business of late, has decreased and did not warrant the maintenance of an operator. The Fort Erie office formerly called F.2 and lately "F" was one of the oldest in the country, having been established by the old Niagara-Penninsula Telegraph Comp. which became merged into the Montreal Telegraph Comp. The Dominion Telegraph also opened an office with the late George Lewis as manager, and F.S. HOUSE as operator. Both offices became merged into the present G.N.W. Telegraph Comp. Some of the ablest operators in the country, received their first lessons in the art of telegraphing here at these offices.
