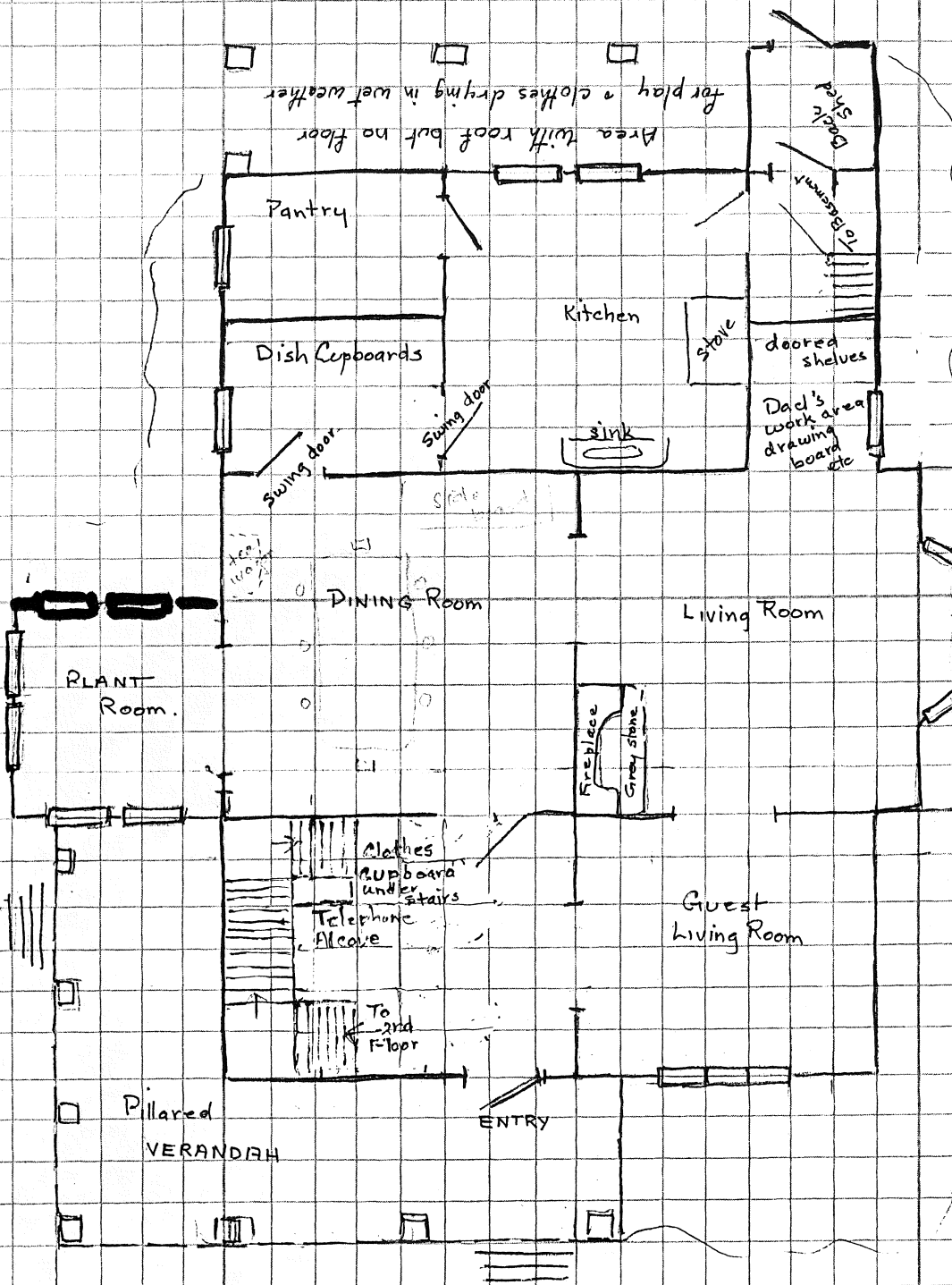
After death of her husban Elsie Fitz. moved back to her old ^{home} homestead # 96 Niagara Blvd. Continued to live there till 1949.

Diagram of 1st floor



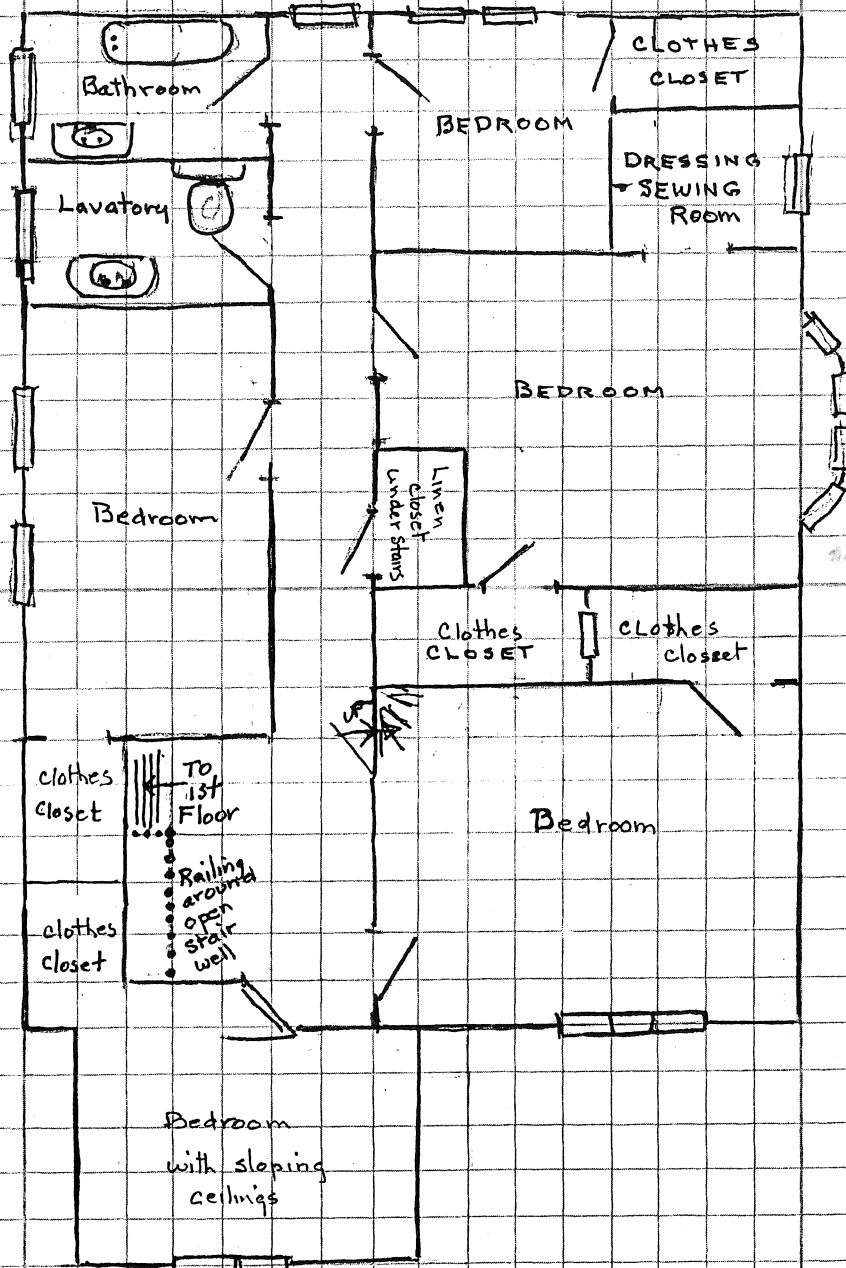
The stove was a coal and gas combination
