This lot apparently went from the same owners as
lot B. the site of the Barnea House, until
June 28. 1873 Stephen M. jaris to Hugh Mc. Cabe :
west 60 ft. of lot A.

Jan. 1873. Adella Mc. Cabe to Hugh Mc. Cabe
Aug. 1893. Hugh Mc. Cabe to Wm. Caren.

(William Caren also received lot B site
of the Barnea from the mortgageholder
Thomas brown in 1893. On the 10th. of
Aug, the same year he sold lot B. to
MARTHA Barnea. No building was erected
on the CR. lot B. except for a small
cottage facing Klauck just before
comming to the laneway.

lot 13. west side of Niagara St. (north of the N.W. cr. of Niagara
& 14 & Courtwright St.

Dec. 18, 1885: Dec. 18. 1885 . Robert G. Barrett sold to the
International Lodge I.O.O.F. the west section of
this lot fronting on Klauck St.

July 23, 1892: Robert G. Barrett sold to the Trustees of the
Presbyterian Church of Victoria.
Their Church building faced Courtwright St. and stood
just east of the I.O.O.F. Lodge.

lot 14. north side of Courtwright St. cr. of Niagara St.

Feb. 1899: William Hogg: Robert Mc. Bean & Thomas Newbigging
trustees of the Presbyterian Church to London Loan Compan

May 13, 1912: William Brown to International Lodge No. 228 order
of Oddfellows & W.B. Seaton trustee.

Jan. 19, 1916 : Fred H. BarrettEx. of Robert Barrett to Herbert Gues
(for guarage which faced the Niagara River road.
