Andrew Miller devised to Peter Miller: 200 acres, lot no. 6. & 7
in the 4th. con. Township of Bertie. Welland County.
to Andrew Miller Jr.: lot 14, con. 6, Bertie Township.100 acres.
also he divised to Andrew Miller Jr., a piece of land where
he now lives: (lot no. 14, his homestead farm)

Composed of: "the south east angle of lot 14, in the 5th., con. of Bertie aforesaid: The said parcel of land is boardered in the front by the Niagara River: in the south by a Creek running south easterly; until it intersects a branch and ravine running north westerly: across the road between lots no. 14, & 15: in the fifth concession containing 20 acres, more or less.

to Benjamin Miller: lot no. 12, in the 5th., con.: containing 100 acres: also the east part of lot no. 13: and the south east angle of lot no. 14, including all the land lying south east of the road, which crosses the said lots commonly called the Ridge Road.

to son Edward::: lot 13, in the 6th. con., containing 100 acres. also the west end of lot n. 13, in the 5th., con.

the rear of the said lot.
