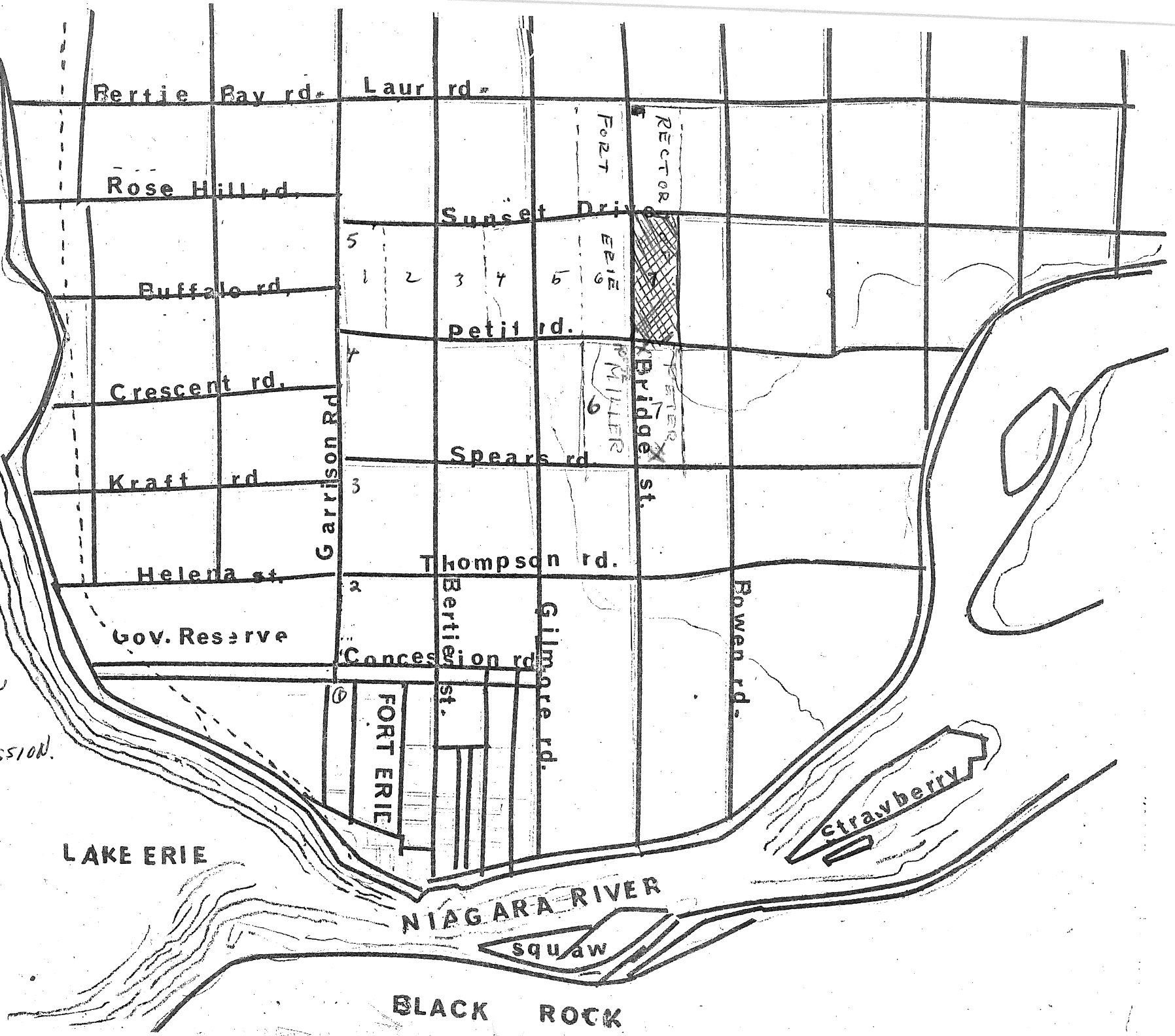

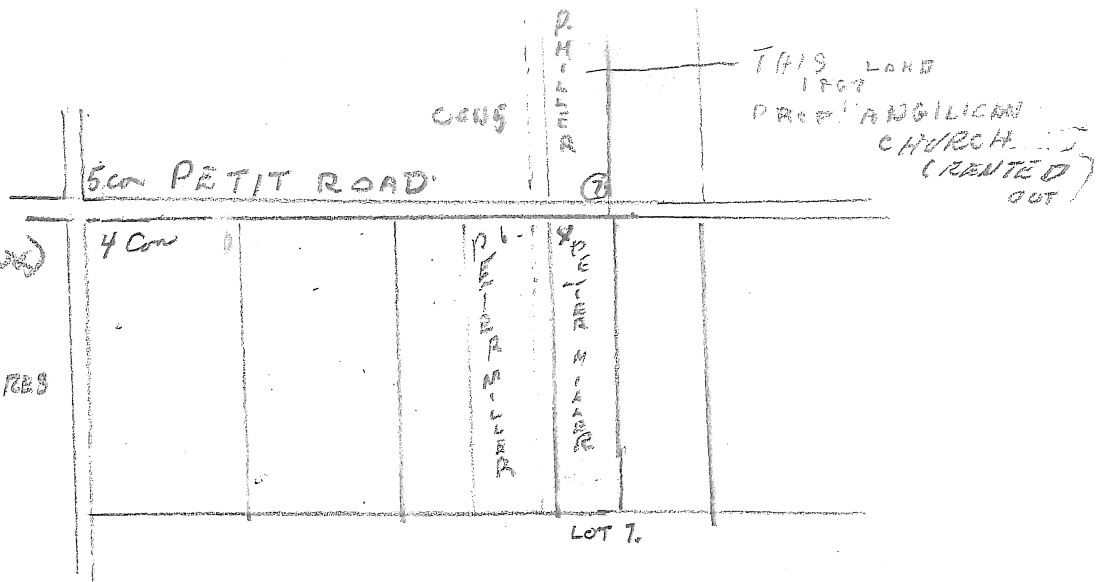

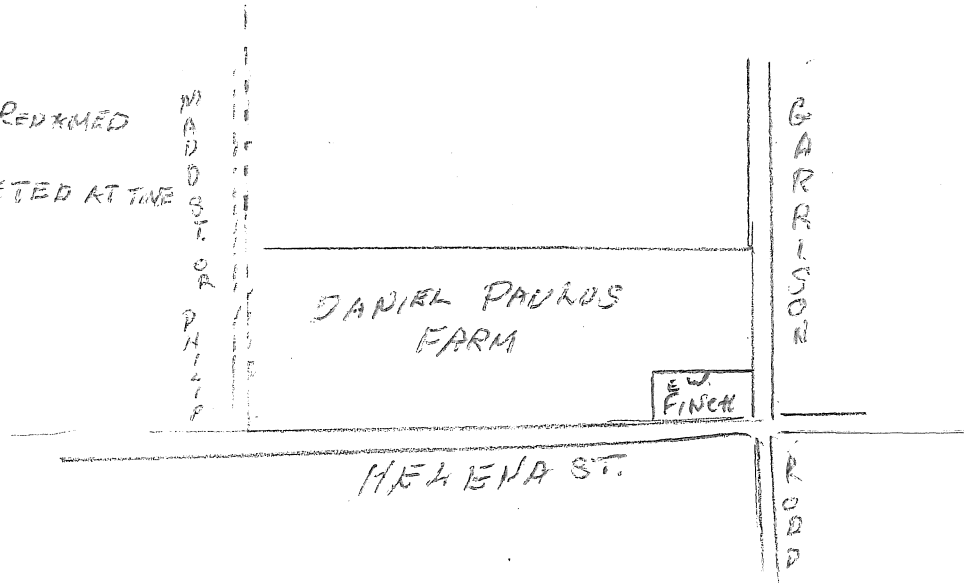

LOT 7 CON 5 - 100 ACRES



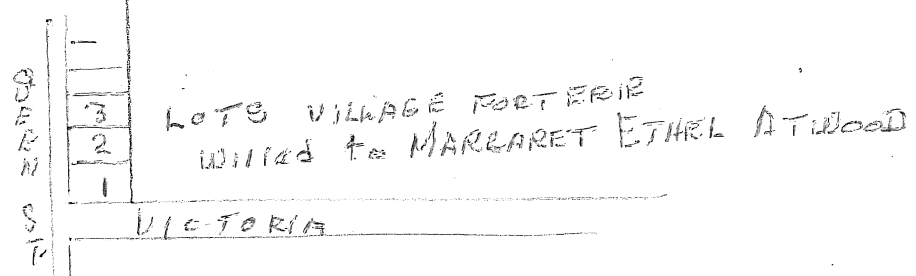
HOMESTEAD farm lot 7 con 4
LOT 6. CON 4 - OWNED BY 1860'S

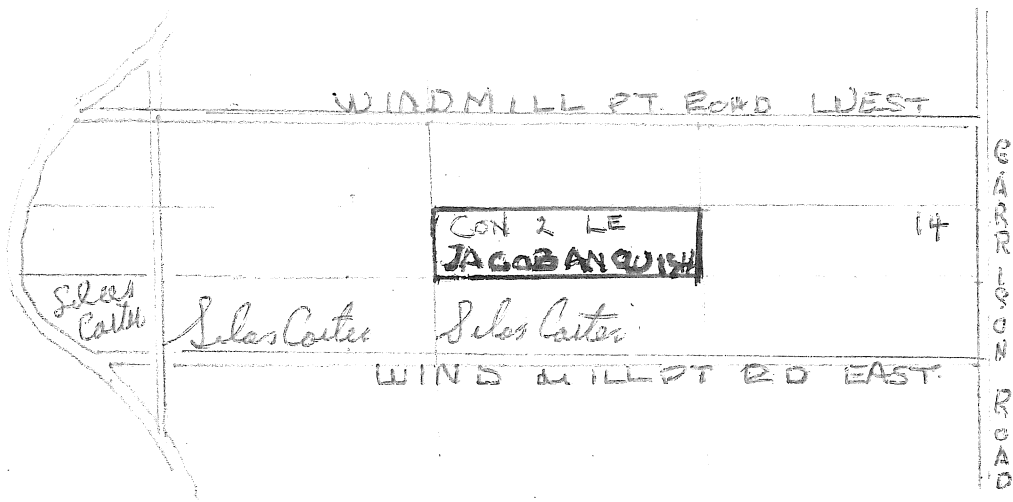

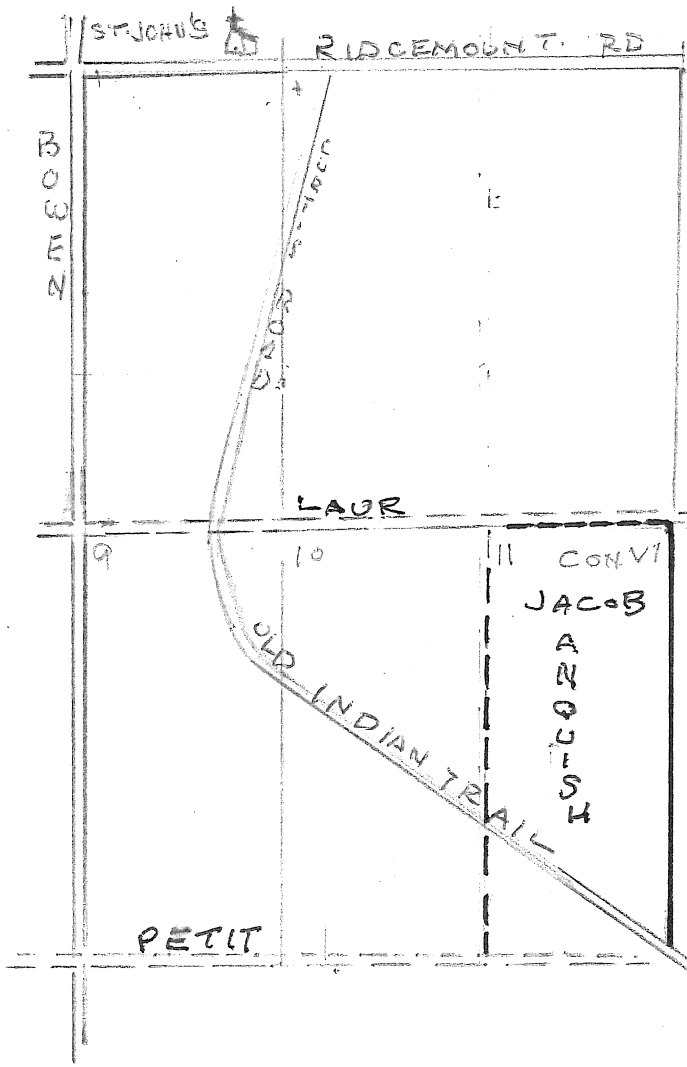
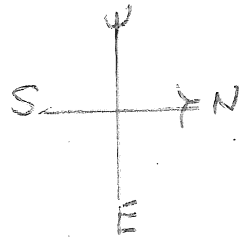

What remained of the ruins, were removed and a new home built in it's place.

May 28th. 1853:::

PETER MILLER SR. left his homestead farm and his property in the Township of Southwald to his sons Peter & Andrew. Peter kept the homestead property lots 6 & 7 in the 4th. con. and Andrew took the lot No. 9 north in Talbot Rd. East in the township of Southwald in the County of Elgin.

May 25th. 1859. lot 6 & 7 in the 4th. con. released to Peter Miller by brother Andrew.
