EVERETT BROTHERS, was under the partnership of Rowland & Burwell Everett; twins born Jan. 25, 1902 near Ridgeway Bertie Township. Their fathers farm was on the old stone mill road opposite the old Baxter Church. His parents were Rowland & Alice Fite Everett.

In 1919 they established themselves in Bridgeburg and Fort Erie. When starting out they had a sales office in a small building on the north side of the Pool hall in the heart of the village. They also used the red barns at the foot of Bertie St. belonging to J.F. Ferguson. In 1926 they opened their new store in the Allen Block on the North side of Jarvis St. They concentrated their attention on the production of milk, cream, & other Dairy products.
