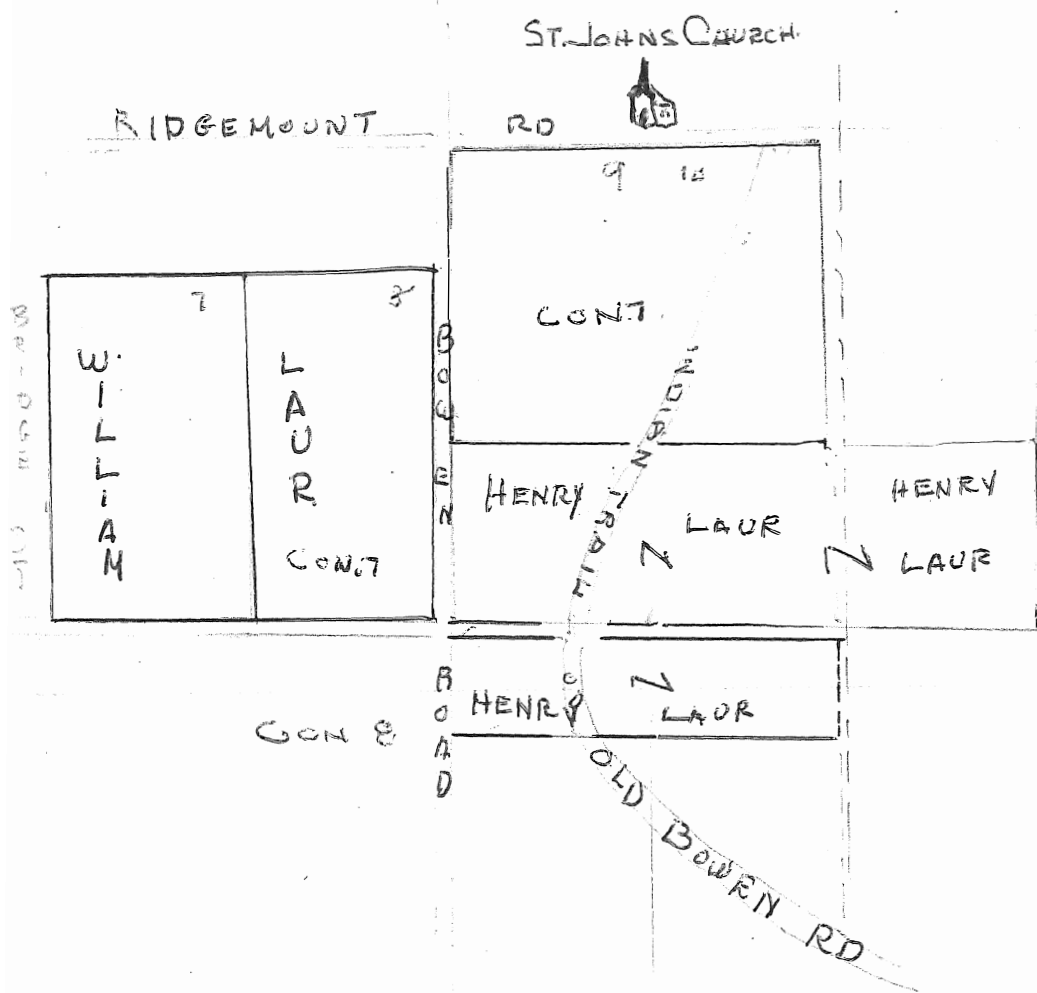
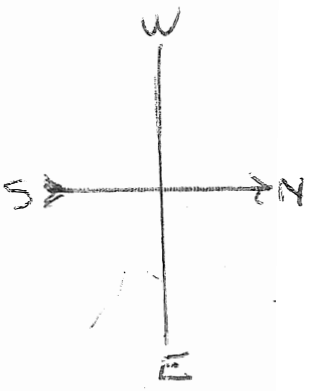


S.G.Dennahower::: Jarvis St. Fort Erie .

Mrs. dennahower was a Flake by her first marriage, lives at 316 Jarvis St. Her mother was Mrs. Hughes. her Grandmother lived in the farm house just west of Phipps St. School. She later lived in this house with her mother. The home was eventually sold and they moved into a small house on Crooks St. next to the house of Ed. Hawkin on the corner. She had two children at the time. She moved from here to Jarvis St. # 316 with her family and has lived there for 81 years.

At one time she worked in the Flat top hotel of Ed Hawkins on Jarvis, which she claims was nicknamed the "#Greezy Spoon". The home at 326 Jarvis was also bought by the Flakes and remodelled. It had been the site of Bill Hanna's Feed & Grain Store, before the turn of the Century.

36. Cranmer Riselay, son of John & Catherine (Miller) Riselay, b. 31 May 1831, d. 14 Dec 1900 and is buried at St. Paul's, Fort Erie. He md. 5 Oct 1859 at St. Paul's Margaret Laur [TOR 1:115] who was b. 22 Sept 1837 and d. 23 Aug 1903 [dates from g. s. at St. Paul's]. She was a daughter of Henry Laur. Cranmer Riselay was for many years a Councillor of Bertie, and in 1883 he was elected Reeve, a position he was re-elected to for three succeeding years. In 1885 the Welland County Council elected him Warden of the County. [Hist. Welland County (1887) p.431]
